FY06 Cultural Development Grant: To support the Ocean in View lecture series—part of a multi-day festival commemorating the 200th anniversary of the Corps of Discovery reaching the mouth of the Columbia River. The project is named after Clark's famous exclamation after first sighting the Pacific Ocean. A series of five lectures covering topics related to Lewis and Clark's impacts on natural history, cultural history, and the regional economy will be presented. A Hollywood and History series will examine the myths behind the Sacagawea story. Lectures will be held at the Astoria Performing Arts Center and the Liberty Theatre in Astoria.
