FY06 Cultural Development Grant: To support the restoration of the vaudeville-era dressing rooms of the historic Hollywood Theatre, built in 1926 and on the National Register of Historic Places. The dressing room areas have been closed for four decades and the restoration of the dressing room areas will allow the 490 seat main stage theatre to provide greater access to performing arts organizations, schools, and community groups.

FY07 Cultural Development Grant: To support the replacement of the stage and organ loft roofs at the historic 1926 era Hollywood Theatre in northeast Portland. Replacement of 17 roof areas on the building is required in order to restore and install a 1925 Robert Morton pipe organ, an instrument that was used during 1926 through 1955 to accompany silent movies and live events at the theatre. Film Action will partner with the Columbia River Organ club to restore the instrument.
