In addition, the Century Community Room, a 900 square foot facility will be built outside the library security area and opened for extended hours when the main library is closed. The smaller space will house an art and historic artifact exhibit in addition to providing space for preschool story times, and meeting space for film series, lectures, book clubs, concerts, and Chautauqua events.
